Dear Parents,

Headlice - Treatment and Prevention

Please can you check your child's hair for headlice at least once a week. This is important in order to make sure that the source is always managed. Local expert advice supports treatment with the Wet Combing Method - at least a weekly check of wet hair at hair wash time to detect headlice using a good quality detection comb and any conditioner. If live lice are detected this method should be used every 3 days for 2-3 weeks in order to prevent re-infection. If you find someone in your family has headlice, it is important to inform all close contacts. **Please can we also ask that children come to school with their hair tied up as this can limit transmission from child to child. Thanks.**

We are so excited about our Christmas Fair next Friday, 28th November. There will be craft stalls, sweet treats, Christmas gifts plus our tombola and raffle. Raffle tickets have gone home already and but there will be more available to buy on the day.
