Social Media Ban

As you will have heard on the news, the UK government will ban social media for under-16s. The government ran a national consultation from March to May 2026, one of the largest engagement exercises undertaken, and the results showed overwhelming public demand for action, with 9 in 10 parents backing a ban and two-thirds of young people agreeing that under-16s should not be allowed to use at least some social media platforms. Currently, most major social media platforms already set a minimum age of 13 to create an account, with additional protections and parental consent requirements for users under 16 in the UK, although these rules are not always consistently enforced. The new changes will go further by resetting the rules so that children are better protected from harmful platforms and online features, and they are expected to come into effect in Spring 2027.

KS2 Primary Athletics

The children had a fantastic day competing in a wide range of both track and field events, showing determination, teamwork, and great sportsmanship throughout.
