Safety Alert - Squishy toys

You may have seen on the news that a safety alert has been issued to consumers and businesses following the seizure of potentially toxic "squishy" toys. Copies of Squishy Dumplings and NeeDoh toys have been found to lack the legally required traceability information, which is essential to demonstrate compliance with UK safety standards. Trading Standards has advised that all toys should clearly display the name and address of a UK-based importer or EU-based manufacturer. They must also carry a mandatory "CE" or "UKCA" marking, confirming they have passed strict safety regulations. To help keep everyone safe, please ensure that squishy toys are not brought into school. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
