SATs results delayed

Please note that the release of Key Stage 2 test results has been delayed. Results, originally due on **7th July 2026**, will now be available on **16th July 2026**. The delay is due to additional time needed by Pearson to ensure the online results portal is ready. It is not related to the quality or accuracy of the test results. The tests have been marked as normal, and the Standards and Testing Agency are confident that the results are accurate.
